

Aldbury Parish Council Filming Policy

- Requests to film within the parish are considered on an individual basis as they come in. The Council's approach is to neither discourage filming nor actively seek out opportunities.
- A draft filming agreement has been agreed by the Parish Council and will be used as the basis for negotiations with filming companies. The fees will not be shared with the filming companies initially.
- The Council has resolved to delegate authority to the Clerk to conclude agreements with the filming company or to end discussions if the fee offered by the company or the disruption likely to be caused is deemed unacceptable by the Clerk. The Council will support the decisions of the Clerk.
- It is expected that the Clerk would consult with Councillors as available and appropriate. Ideally one or two Councillors would meet with the filming company along with the Clerk.
- It is expected that the Clerk would consult with any local residents who might be considered likely to be seriously adversely affected by the filming
- Resident feedback was sought as part of the 2022 Annual Assembly and this suggested that residents weren't adverse to filming within the parish. The Council will continue to take into account feedback from residents as part of the process of keeping the policy under review.
