## Clerk's Report & Correspondence – APC Meeting on 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2025

## Matters and actions from previous meeting(s):

- The gateway signs to Tring Station have been installed.
- A cheque for £2,500 was received from Aldbury Sports Club. This payment includes £2,400 for grass cutting at the Recreation Ground and £100 for rent.
- After consulting with the Chairman, I have decided to postpone moving to Tomato Energy. This decision is due to ongoing enquiries from HCC regarding our streetlights. The contract with Tomato Energy is for two years, which means APC would not be able to terminate it if HCC is to take over the streetlights at some point.
- The warden provided feedback about areas affected by dog fouling, which was circulated to members. I suggest that he monitors these areas for now and reports back if the problem persists.
- The Precept forms received on 7<sup>th</sup> January were duly signed by Cllrs Webb, de la Bedoyere and Warren on 28<sup>th</sup> January (wet signature) and were submitted to DBC.
